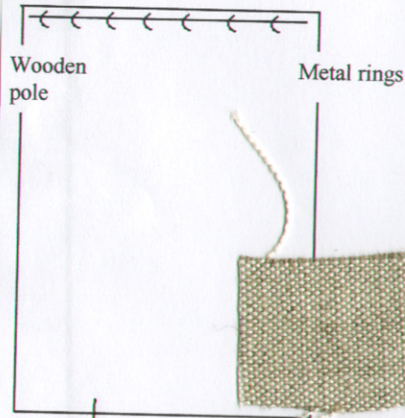


## Manufacturing specification

Back View



Backing material will be a linen cotton in a dark blue if possible.

Front view



Each of these panels should be identical

This triangular panel should be identical to the one opposite.

### Stitches

To stitch each panel to the next: length 1 width 3  
Appliqué stitch: length 0.5 width 4

### Components

7 metal rings approximately 2cm in diameter  
100cm bamboo or dowel pole approximately 1cm in diameter

### Materials

For the panels polycotton will be used in bright red (Italy)

Orange (Spain)  
Yellow (Holland)  
Green (France)  
Blue (the centre circle and triangles either side)

Need 3/4 m in each colour at £4/m

A burgundy synthetic silk should be used for the wine bottle. 1/2 m  
At £ 4.25 /m



Black lace used to decorate the Spanish dancers dress. 1/2 m at 32p /m.



With the left over material other objects on the wall hanging will be made out of those cottons e.g. the yellow pizza base  
Very small amounts of cotton in other colours will be needed (no more than a 1/4 m for each colour).

- The brown centre of the sunflower
- The black windows of the leaning tower and the windmill

The EU stars will be made out of bright yellow shiny polyester  
The Spanish dancers dress and the tulips will be made out of red shiny polyester. The bull and the gondola will be made out of a black shiny polyester.  
1/2 m needed in all three colours.  
At £3.75/m

Various different felts will be needed:

- Bright red for the windmill sails, for the tomato on the pizza, for part of the gondola stick and for the paint drops. 1/2 m
- Brown felt for the windmill building, the pizza crust and for the paintbrush handle. 1/2 m.
- Yellow for the sun, the words and the euro sign. 1/2 m
- Black for the Spanish lady's hair and the end of the paintbrush. \*1/4 m
- White for the other part of the gondola stick and for the label on the wine bottle. \*1/4 m
- A very light pink or a very light brown for the Spanish dancers skin \*1/4 m
- A bright purple for the grapes. \* 1/4 m
- Light green for the stalks of the grapes and for the tulip stalks. \*1/4 m  
At £3/m

\* 1/4 of a meter was the smallest length they would sell me in the shops but it would have been preferable to buy smaller pieces as then less material would be wasted, and the cost would be reduced. When the wall hanging is batch produced, the quantities of fabrics can be more accurately determined as the repeat patterns will be laid out to minimise wastage.
